4th Annual Critter Lift to benefit the SPCA happening Saturday

CHARLOTTESVILLE, VA (October 13, 2022) —The 4th Annual Critter Lift and Rummage Store Extravaganza is happening at the SPCA Rummage Store on Saturday, October 15. The Rummage Store will be hosting a fun shopping event and donation drive to benefit the animals at the Charlottesville-Albemarle SPCA. Last year, the event raised more than \$7,300 for animals in need.

The Critter Lift is scheduled from 10 AM to 6 PM. There will be new specialty items for sale that have been held throughout the year, the Compassionate Care-A-Van will be on-site with adoptable dogs, and there will also be door prizes, a face painter, and bins to drop off much-needed supplies for the SPCA.
