### **Charlottesville-Albemarle SPCA to Hold 10th Annual bow-WOW-walk**

**Charlottesville, VA (April 21, 2023)** – The Charlottesville-Albemarle SPCA will hold its 10<sup>th</sup> annual bow-WOW-walk on Saturday, April 22<sup>nd</sup> at Boar’s Head Resort. The SPCA impacts thousands of homeless and owned animals each year through sheltering, low-cost clinics, and pet food assistance. The bow-WOW-walk is critical to funding these lifesaving efforts.

Registration for the walk begins at 9 AM, the competitive 5K run begins at 10:30 AM, the noncompetitive 5K dog walk begins at 11:00 AM, and post-walk festivities will follow. The event will feature human and pet entertainment, canine competitions, treats for humans and pups, and animal-friendly sponsors. Last year’s bow-WOW-walk was a huge hit, raising over \$74,000. The goal this year is to raise \$100,000 to support the SPCA’s mission.
