## Charlottesville-Albemarle SPCA Acknowledged by Best Friends Animal Society for 90% Save Rate in 2022

**CHARLOTTESVILLE, VA (October 13, 2023)** — The Charlottesville-Albemarle SPCA has been acknowledged by Best Friends Animal Society for achieving a 90% save rate in the 2022 calendar year, joining an elite group of organizations across the country.

Best Friends Animal Society is a nationally recognized animal welfare organization working to end the euthanizing of dogs and cats in America's shelters by 2025. The organization runs lifesaving programs across the country, as well as the nation's largest no-kill animal sanctuary. Best Friends also works collaboratively with a network of more than 4,400 animal welfare and shelter partners, and community members nationwide.

"It is an honor to receive this acknowledgement from Best Friends," said Sue Friedman, Interim Executive Director of the Charlottesville-Albemarle SPCA. "This accomplishment truly represents CASPCA's culture of compassion and the hard work of our dedicated staff and volunteers."

"Although 90% is, by definition, a number, organizations that achieve and maintain no kill are made up of people who never forget that each fraction of those percentage points represents a life saved," said Julie Castle, Chief Executive Officer of Best Friends Animal Society.
